11th – 13th September 2018 Trat Province (Fisheries Refugia Site), Thailand

WORKPLAN AND TIMETABLE

This paper aims to introduce the initial workplan and timetable based on the Project Cooperation Agreement between UNEP and SEAFDEC signed in March 2016. However, the LOA between SEAFDEC and participating six Countries have signed since January 2017 till present there were four countries namely Cambodia, Malaysia, Philippines and Thailand. It is expected that the remaining two countries, namely Indonesia and Viet Nam will be signed on the LOA or LOI within 2018. In this connection, the initial workplan and timetable for countries implementation is required for adjustment based upon the individual country initiatives. It is expected that the country workplan will be adjusted within the time frame from 2017 to 2020 and proposes for endorsement by the 1st Project Steering Committee
