Indicators assist in the process of assessing the performance of fisheries policies and management at global, regional, national, and sub-national levels.



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
SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT CONCEPT


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LONG-TERM OBJECTIVES


- Maintain the fish stock and critical habitats:
