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

#### 1. General Information





- ✓ Lao PDR is a mountainous and landlocked country.
- ✓ > 80 % is agriculture: Cultivation, Livestock and Fisheries.
- ✓ Fisheries models: Family fisheries and commercial fisheries

## Six fish group of targeted species



- ✓ Lao PDR: found 2 species in **Family Engraulidae**: *Lycothrissa crocodilus* (pa mak chan; pa meo) and *Setipinna melanochir*.
- ✓ Source Found:
- Downstream from the Khone Falls to the Mekong Delta
- Mekong Delta up to the Tonle Sap






## Fishing months of the fisheries

  - found >1,200 species
- ✓ Lao PDR: found > 500 species.

#### **Spawning season (months):**


✓ Rain season: May to September

- ✓ Upstream
- ✓ Floodplain areas






#### Migration pattern of the species

Rain season – migration for spawning
 (River, Floodplain areas, Upstream)


Dry season – seek refuge
 (wetlands, river channel, deep pools)
